For the Dec 4th working bee meet at gate 82 entrance to the Reserve, in from the water tanks on Hillside rd, Springfield.

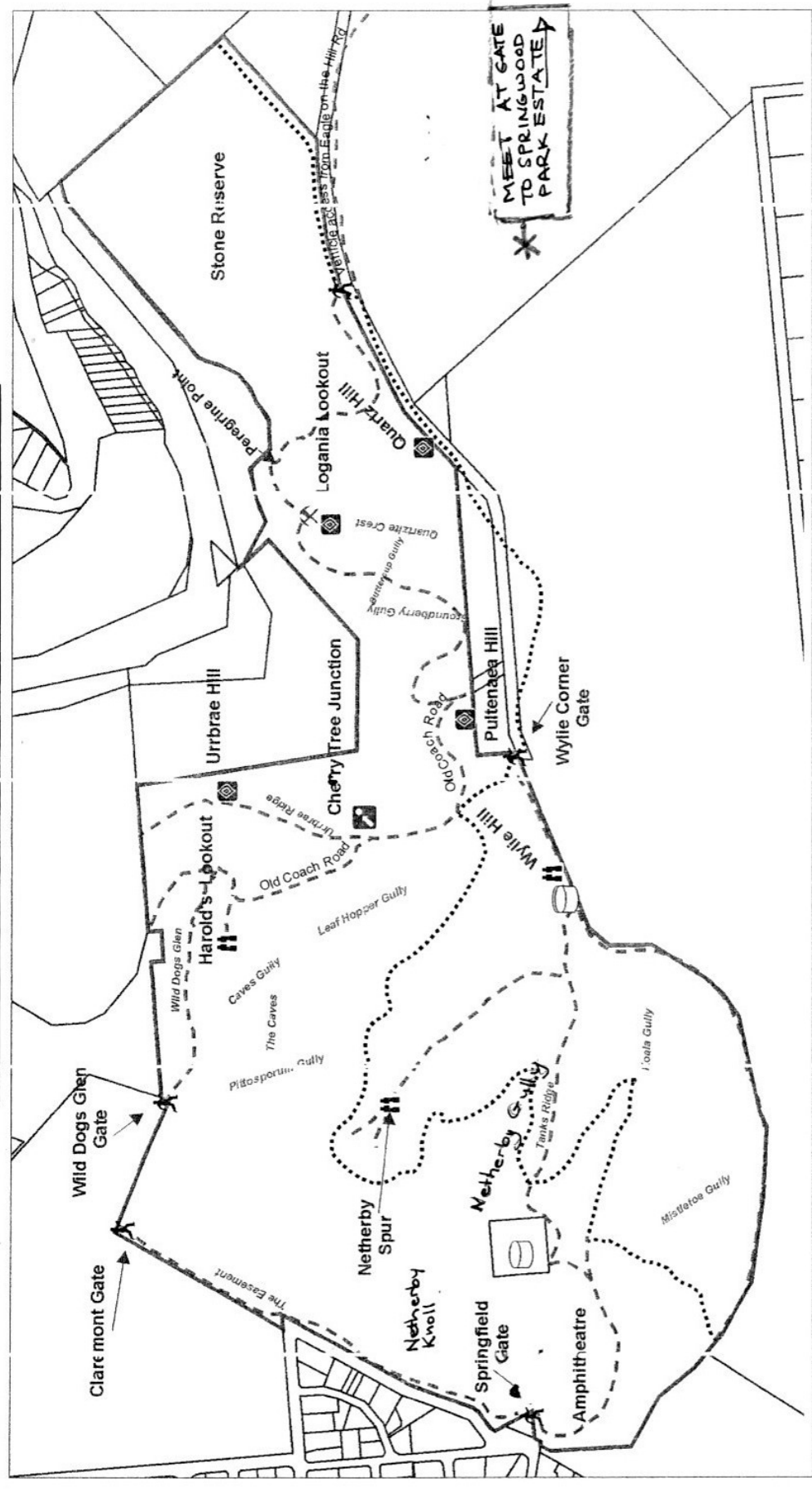

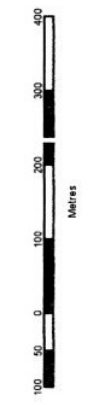
