Meeting place

Meet at the driveway to the Springwood Park property, which adjoins the eastern end of the Reserve. To get there, turn left off the SE Freeway on to the Eagle on the Hill Rd. This is signed after Mt Osmond and before the tunnels. The driveway is the first possible right hand turn, which occurs after several bends in the road going up the hill. The "old" house at the end of the driveway has now been demolished.

Activities

Activities for the rest of the year include weeding of bulbs along Urbrae Ridge, weeding of veldt grass from Hardy Block, weeding of African orchid, planting of native midstory species, lilies and grasses, seed collection for future revegetation projects, the installation of seats and a table in Wild Dogs Glen, and the collection of metal sheeting used in last year's fauna survey.
